



ROC-ED Membership Rules

- 1) Current Coggins for all horses to be included in ROC-ED activities must be on file with ROC-ED
- 2) SEI certified ASTM Standard F 1163 Equestrian Helmet, Property fitted and worn at all times.
- 3) All members must have a liability release on file
- 4) Minors under the age of 16 must have an adult present
- 5) Minors between the age of 16-18 must have a parental/Guardian release on file.
- 6) Trails are for ROC-ED members only
- 7) Trails are only open during day light hours
- 8) Trails are closed when they are muddy (see website for details)
- 9) All members must have their membership tags clearly displayed when on ROC-ED property
- 10) Members may have guests with them
- 11) Members guests must have guest tags clearly displayed
- 12) If asked for proof of your membership you must provide it
- 13) No loose dogs
- 14) Walk left to left when passing on coming riders
- 15) Stay on marked trails at all times
- 16) Ride slowly and as quietly as possible when near residences/Pastures/barns/other animals
- 17) Obey all posted signs
- 18) Leave gates as you found them
- 19) DO NOT LITTER
- 20) Do not smoke
- 21) Do not ride on unmarked trails or unauthorized places
- 22) Do not use anything belonging to a landowner including but not limited to: rings, jumps, picnic tables, ponds/lakes, boats without prior written permission
- 23) Report all problems directly to ROC-ED- do not try to accost anyone on your own
- 24) Do not pick landowners flowers/produce/fruit
- 25) Be courteous at all times
- 26) If you trailered in please clean up after you and your horse (manure/hay/etc)

Not abiding by these rules will earn the member disciplinary actions including probationary period on membership and revocation of membership.
